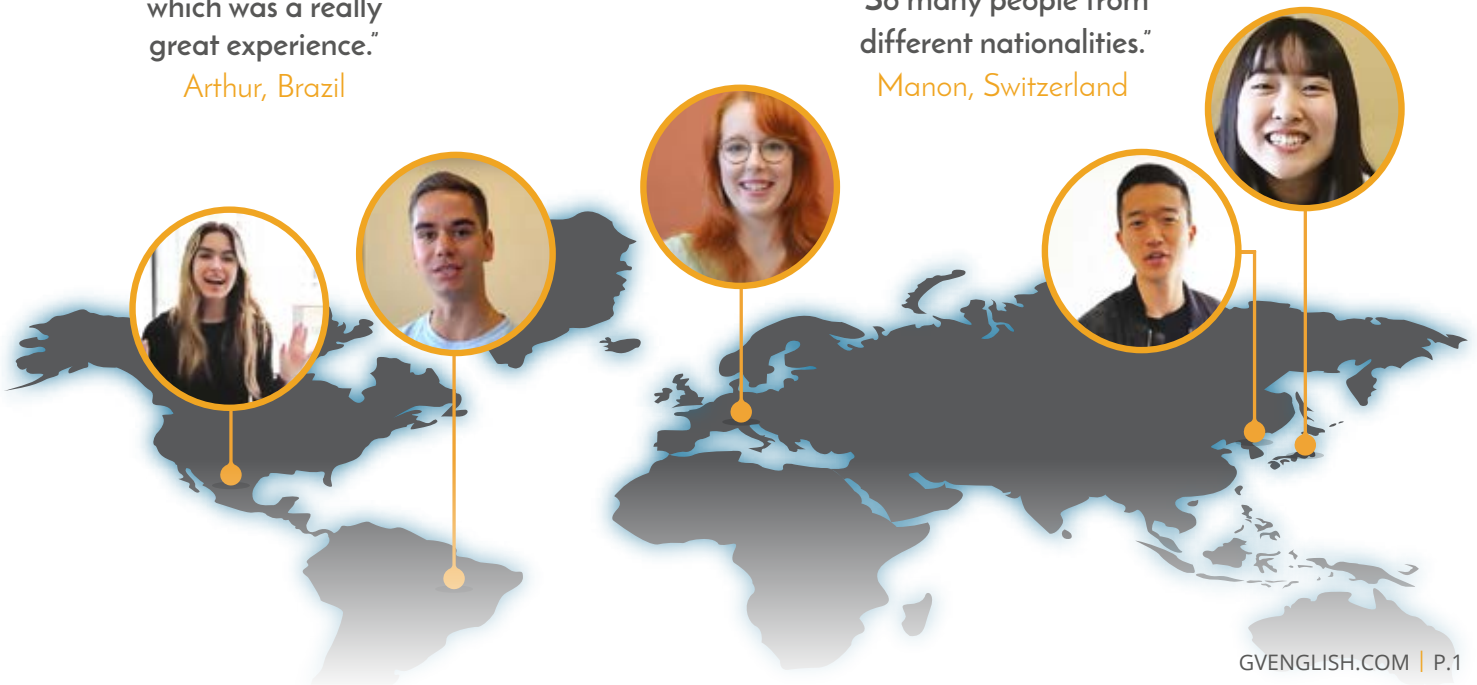

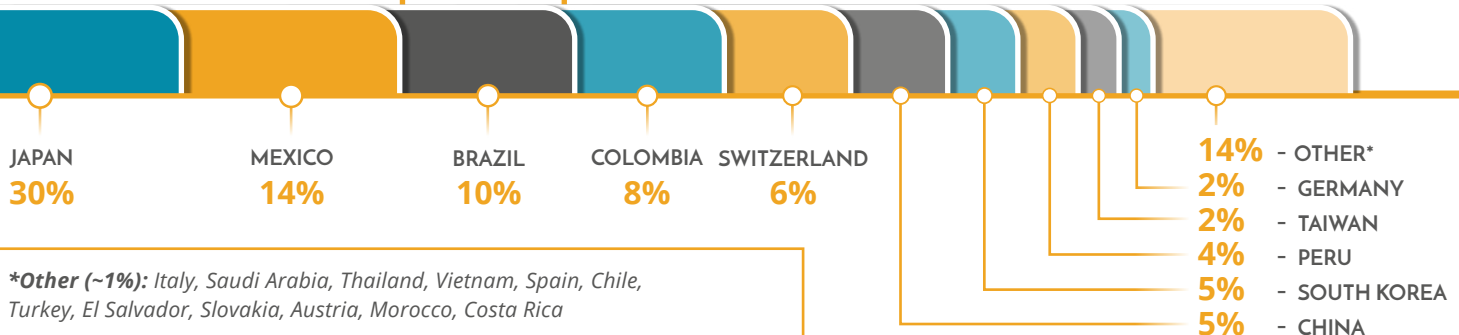

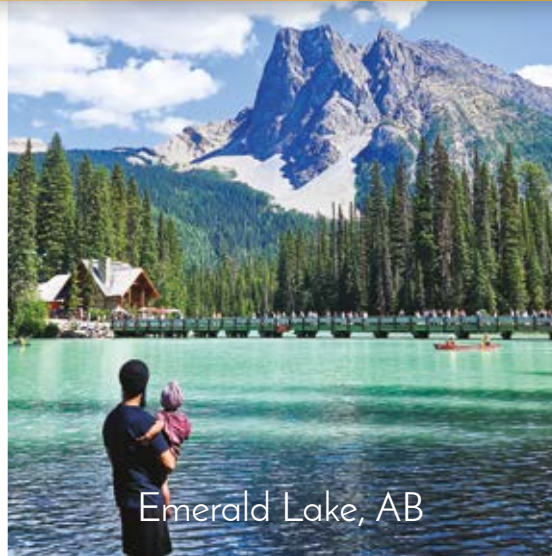

- > Available at 20, 25, or 30 lessons per week and offered at eight levels: Beginner to Mastery.
- > Can be taken for 1 to 52+ weeks!
- > **Weekly start dates.**

ENGLISH FOR ACADEMIC PURPOSES (EAP) ————— Placement Test Required

- > This course helps you achieve your academic goals by assisting you in transitioning to college or university.
- > Available at 30 lessons per week. Placement test required to determine length of study required for Pathways exit.
- > Combines 20 lessons of GEP prep in the morning with 10 lessons of academic pathway electives in the afternoon.

IELTS PREPARATION ————— Entry Level: CEFR B2- C2 (GV5-8)

- > In this course, our IELTS specialists use a vast set of resources to help you achieve your desired IELTS results!
- > Victoria: 10 or 30 lessons per week | IELTS 30 Prep includes morning GEP classes and afternoon IELTS electives.
- > Calgary: 7.5 lessons per week | Evening classes on Tuesday and Thursday.
- > **Start Dates: V:** Weekly start dates | **C:** February 4th (Ends April 24th) and September 9th (Ends November 27th)

BUSINESS ENGLISH ————— Entry Level: CEFR B2- C2 (GV5-8)

GENERAL ENGLISH PROGRAM (GEP)



The General English Program (GEP) is the “Launchpad” program at Global Village.

With classes for Beginner to Advanced students, we'll have the fit for your current proficiency and future goals. Face-to-face real-time contact in small classes and a wide nationality mix of interesting, motivated students and professionals, ensure full immersion in the language with plenty of engaging dialogue, practice, and correction by qualified and experienced instructors.

- Weekly intake
- Eight levels from Beginner to Mastery
- Average 8-12 weeks per level
- Emphasis placed on conversation and spoken language
- Improves students' ability to speak English in practical situations
- Integrates all skill areas (speaking, listening, reading and writing)
- Core program focuses on communicative grammar and functional dialogue
- Elective classes further develop accuracy, vocabulary, and fluency
- Regular proficiency testing and personal feedback meetings to measure student progress

BUSINESS ENGLISH (Minimum Age: 18)

(International English Language Testing System)

CELPIP

(Canadian English Language Proficiency Index Program)

CELPIP is an exam which measures listening, reading, writing, and speaking skills for immigration, citizenship, or professional designation in Canada. The CELPIP Preparation evening class will give you practice in all four skill areas while improving your knowledge of Canadian customs and culture.

UNIVERSITY & COLLEGE PATHWAYS



University & College Pathways is designed to prepare GV students to succeed at a Canadian college or university.

This course focuses on strengthening general language skills, especially in advanced level communication skills and academic reading and writing skills. The course also covers essay writing, research papers, study skills, note-taking, presentations and research.

As part of the course, regular meetings with the Pathway Advisor are scheduled.

These meetings will not only review academic progress on the pathway, but can also cover the application process and communication with the college/university to ensure a successful transfer.

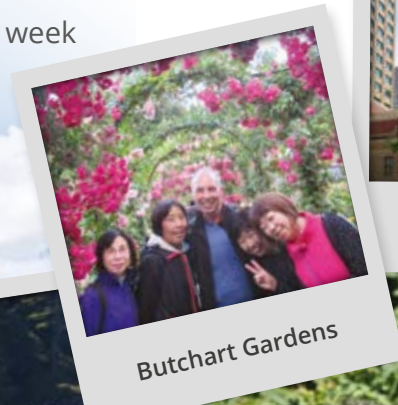
