





- The Bachelor of Science in Nursing program is offered in partnership with the University of Victoria, with all four years held at our Cranbrook main campus.
- Nursing students can take part in study abroad opportunities.
- Kinesiology students are eligible for CSEP Certified Personal Trainer certification at the end of their second year – a year ahead of students at many other institutions.






GET THE TOOLS OF THE TRADES

We have successfully trained more than 8,000 foundation-level and apprenticeship students to help fill the in-demand jobs that fuel the economy and support communities. Construction trades, Industrial trades, and Service trades - build your dream career with us.

DID YOU KNOW

- Over the past five years, we've acquired approximately \$2.5 million in trades equipment to enhance our programs.
- According to B.C.'s Labour Market Outlook: 2022 Edition, a variety
 of industries are expected to have thousands of job openings in the
 apprenticeable skilled trades over the next 10 years.
- The trades most in demand over the next 10 years include cooks, automotive service technicians, hairstylists, carpenters, electricians, welders, plumbers, industrial mechanics, and heavy duty mechanics.
- Start your trades training while in high school with the TRAIN (Youth Train in Trades) program. Talk to your high school counsellor for more information.
